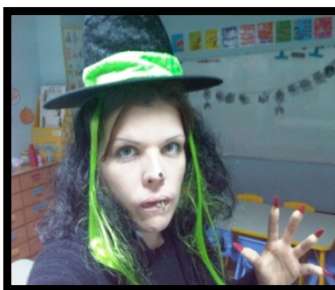

Comments -

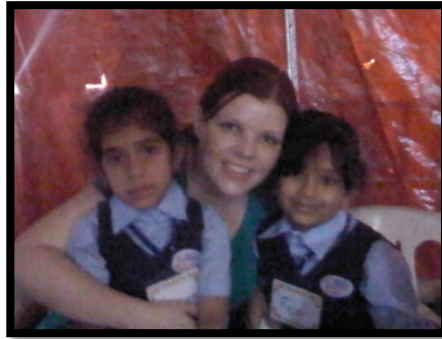
